From old vines in five districts, fermented with submerged cap, matured in French oak (32% new) for 15 months. Complex and rich from the first whiff, it doesn't waste a single berry of this great vintage. So much power, such elegance.

Vibrant, and proud. This opaque wine opens with a healthy dose of oak, with a brooding core of fruit releasing teases of tapenade and cinnamon.
