**97 points , Jane Faulkner, Halliday Wine Companion, August 2020**

Entity is always a complete, fabulous wine. Nothing out of place. Cherry picking fruit from sites off old vines across the Eden and Barossa Valleys. It is so polished, there's a sheen. Flavours of black fruits, licorice and woody spices all in sync. The key is beautifully shaped and plush tannins. Wonderful wine.

Entity 2018 is all about generosity and harmony. Dark berries and plum are perfectly integrated with savoury and sweet notes of spice, cedary French oak is woven through without any woody edges. The texture is almost unctuously smooth, flowing long and velvety with perfectly integrated tannins worked through seamlessly. Lovely Australian wine.

**94 points, Campbell Mattinson, The Wine Front, April 2020**

Duval's Entity Shiraz nails it again. This is walk up quality. Deep dark berried fruit flavours, swish smoky/cedary oak, ripples of spice-infused tannin. Plenty of length, all fine and filigreed. It's warm-hearted but it's manicured. It's also eminently seductive.
