94 points, Lisa Perrotti-Brown, The Wine Advocate, October 2016 Medium to deep garnet-brick colored, the 2005 Plexus has an alluring earthy, meaty, gamey nose over dried mulberry, kirsch and sandalwood at its core. The palate is wonderfully ripe, rich and concentrated, with a seductively soft texture and great length.

I love the interplay of sweet, juicy fruit, supple tannins and understated oak. Finishes with the clarity, complexity and persistence of wines that cost three times the price. Once of the greatest values in Australian wine today.
