The Crimson-purple hue puts the often insipid colour of Barossa Valley SGM's to shame; the fragrant bouquet and vibrant black cherry and plum fruit of the palate likewise; quality French oak has been used to maximum advantage.

Full red-purple, good colour. Young but dusty/earthy aromas dominate. Attractive savoury, nicely concentrated but not over-wrought wine. Intense, deep and layered, full of interest and has a nice core of fruit sweetness, while the finish is clean and dry – and long. Even a touch of elegance to it. Very good wine.

Polished, round and plus, but not over the top, offering a mouthful or ripe blueberry, blackberry, cream and spice flavours that merge seamlessly and persistent through the long, refined finish. Shiraz Grenache and Mourvedre. Drink now through 2020.
