2010 PLEXUS SGM

Medium to deep garnet in color, the 2010 Plexus is starting to morph into a meaty, savory nose with core of kirsch and blueberry preserves, plus potpourri and a touch of cranberry sauce. The palate has great structure, still—all rounded and plush—with maturing, savory fruit leading to a very long finish.

Figgy, prune & a little alcoholic smelling at first, but as it opens up, sweet-earthy Mourvedre characters build, plus abundant forest berries smells. There's a gentleness before it gets richer and loaded with fruit cake and dark chocolate. A seriously smart wine from a master of his craft.

The Shiraz, Grenache and mourvedre blend from Duval is a very handy wine in the 2010 vintage, showing an array of creamy summer berry fruits on the nose, some smooth, cedary oak adding spice here too: fresh and intense. The palate has supple, lively kick, toasty oak wafts through the ripe plum, pomegranate and summer berry fruit flavours, and there's a touch of leather to the close.
