As is appropriate, complex, but largely fruit-driven, with red cherries/ berries and plums to the fore, oak and (particularly) tannins taking a back seat.

Glossy, tangy, sumptuous dark berry fruits form an enticing core supported by impressively gauged dark chocolate oak, finely structured, beautifully polished tannins and well integrated acidity. It lingers long with even line. An impressive vintage for Plexus.

Rich, dark and spicy with chocolate nougat and subtle floral notes. Medium bodied, savoury, spicy, fruity and fleshy all at once, textured grainy tannin, balanced acidity, blackberry with some red fruited freshness on a long finish. Feels almost minerally. Tastes great.
