Deep red/purple colour, with a lovely raspberry and floral bouquet that's full of charm and this transfers well to the palate, which tastes elegant and unforced. There is abundant fruit sweetness in the heart of it, the tannins are ripe and supple and swaddle the wine in layers of savoury fine-grained tannins that harmonise superbly. A great grenache-driven blend and a bargain!

The wine is delightfully approachable at this early stage. Soft, supple and bright with such silky tannins, this is simply too easy to drink, though will reward at any stage over the next four to six years. Notes of cherries, florals and raspberries. Lovely drinking and should score even higher in a few years. If you have not yet joined the Grenache bandwagon, this is your chance.

Even with its user-friendly style, this wine delivers. It's fun but a little bit serious too, with a blend of plummy, red liquorice fruits with nice touches of spice and earth, with fruit generous and ready to go. The palate is more in the jubey spectrum with fleshy red and dark fruits with an attractive earthy, spicy edge plus quite a long and delightfully silky finish. Great early-drinking style.
