2023 CONCILIO GRENACHE

REVIEWS

93 points, Ryan Montgomery, James Suckling.com, November 2024

Bright and lifted aromas of red currants, tobacco leaves, raspberry coulis and dried herbs. The palate is medium-bodied with finely integrated tannins and acidity, giving notes of strawberries, cassia bark and spices. Polished and refined. 86% grenache and 14% shiraz. Drink or hold. Screw cap.

93 points, Dave Brookes, Halliday Wine Companion February 2025

A blend of 86/14% Tanunda grenache/Moppa shiraz from a single site in Ebenezer. Smelling bright and fragrant with fruit tones of red cherry, mulberry, boysenberry with some cranberry lift and hints of spice, citrus blossom, red licorice, pan juices, gingerbread and charcuterie. Airy on the palate with a slide of sour cherry and dried citrus rind, bright acidity and snappy red fruit as it departs.

93 points, Stuart Knox, The Real Review January 2025

Medium to deep ruby with purple rim. Raspberry and bramble nose. Fleshy berry fruit on entry with savoury herbal and meaty undertones. The medium weight is bound by gravelly tannins, accentuating contrast between sweet fruit and dark meaty savouries. A lot happening at this price point. Drink 2025-2033

92 points, Gary Walsh, The Wine Front, February 2024

86% Grenache with 14% Shiraz. Up to one third whole bunches. Cherry, raspberry, some green peppercorn, a little bit meaty. Light to medium-bodied, fresh and frisky, ginger and red fruits, a light grainy grip to tannin shapes it up nicely, and the finish is long, dusty and spicy, with a cinch of orange peel bitterness. So nicely done. You could even give it a slight chill.
