2023 COMPONO CABERNET SAUVIGNON

REVIEWS

This is the second release of this cabernet sauvignon, sourced from the northern Barossa subregion of Moppa with the balance (35%) coming from Hutton Vale in the Eden Valley. Fine, elegant and detailed with characters of ripe blackberry, black cherry and crème de cassis with hints of spice rack, tobacco, dried herbs, sage, black cherry paste, cedar, earth and violet tone notes. Graceful with a harmonious composition, powdered schisty tannins and mineral cadence, finishing long and satisfying.

The nose is rich and savory, with aromas of blood plums, dark cherries, mocha and dried herbs. The palate is full-bodied with fine tannins and bright acidity, giving notes of blackcurrants, graphite and cured meat. Wonderfully complex with a fresh undertone. Drink or hold. Screw cap.
