John Duval might be best known for his work with red grapes, but his Rhone-inspired white blend is no slouch. It's lighter and fresher, finer than expected, but still delivers elements of each variety in the mesh. There's a slickness to the texture, spice nuance and a ripe, fresh stone-fruit profile in the mix. Wonderful balance too.

The 2014 Plexus Blanc reveals pronounced notes of warm peaches, baking bread, honeyed pears and baking spices. Medium-bodied, it is wonderfully fresh in the mouth with a satiny texture and great persistence.
