Pale in colour but then immediately displays exotic, subtly lifted fruits; sweet apricot and a touch of lanolin and blossom aromas with good intensity. The palate is then dry and quite savoury in the mouth with a bit of grip and good fruit intensity which drives it home to a long and complex finish. The whole package is still quite closed and bound up tight, so needs some time to blossom but very good vintage of this label. Drink 2024-2028

John Duval's Plexus, a Rhône-inspired white blend, is consistently delicious. This release is a blend of 59/43/8% roussanne/marsanne/ viognier. Plate straw in the glass, with vivid aromas of sherbety citrus and stone fruits, underscored by hints of soft spice, marzipan, clotted cream and white flowers. Detailed, pithy and refreshing, it's textural and moreish to the end.
