Perfumed and vibrant aromas of orange blossoms, lemon balm and Asian pears. The palate is medium-bodied with a textured mouthfeel and focused acidity, giving notes of fresh apricots, peaches, nectarines and chalk. Made from a blend of 53% marsanne, 28% roussane and 19% viognier.

#### 90 pts Huon Hooke, The Real Review 15 December 2025

Light yellow hue. Dried herb and slightly peppery aromas, a trace of smoky bacon bone. The wine is light and dry, crisp and lean, with good tension and drive, if not great complexity (yet). Lemony acidity completes the super-clean, very dry finish. This is good now and would reward another year or two in the bottle.
