**95 points, Nick Butler, The Real Review, May 2019**

Medium purple colour, bright and youthful. Very fragrant - violets, red plums and oak-spice. A lovely raspberry overlay. Supple and softly red-fruited when sipped. Terrific length and structure with acidity to reward cellaring. Delicious wine.

**94 points, Campbell Mattinson, The Wine Front, July 2018**

Exquisite grenache. Fruit driven at heart but spicy and svelte to boot. Drinking it, to steal a line from Bonnie Tyler, is like living in a powder keg and giving off sparks. It runs a smooth line of flavour from start to finish but keeps flinging tangents of flavour here and there as it goes. Excellent.

**5 star, Lester Jesberg, Wine Wise, June 2018**

This is definitely not the typical Turkish delight Barossa grenache. The dark berry/raspberry fruit carries very pleasing complex notes that the French sometimes refer to as garrigue (herbs of Provence). The tannins are super-fine on the palate that is sumptuous but not heavy. A very special grenache.
